Interview with DC Bloom revealed a dispute between him and former girlfriend, Staci Reshen. He claimed she kept the financial and billing records while she worked there. He also claimed there was a burglary to his business after she was fired in which Reshen's and other's medical records

were taken. That information was corroborated through J80 incident report #2013-379621. Consequently, Reshen produced her and other's medical records when she met with Detective Jason Clark to report fraudulent activity by DC Bloom. He, of course, blamed her if there was any fraudulent billing and Reshen blamed him. Reshen also alleged DC Bloom was giving illegal steroid injections to K█████ S█████. A follow-up interview with S█████ revealed he was receiving B-12 injections at the clinic which also served as a weight loss practice. A search through ACISS revealed Reshen had a previous complaint against another Chiropractor in 2005 (case #05-549/10). Reshen was the primary source of this complaint. She held a position at the business which gave her access to the billing records. The complaints were related to treatments for her and family members while she was employed there, but not made until after her termination of employment. Reshen's allegations appeared biased and unreliable. There was no way to determine who was responsible for submitting the suspect billing since they both blamed each other.
